APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Wisconsin Association for Food Protection (WAFP) welcomes your application for the \$2,000 Technical College award, or the \$3,000.00 College or University award or the \$3,000 E. H. Marth Scholarship. These awards are intended to promote and sustain interest in fields of study which may lead to a career in sanitation, culinary arts, food microbiology, or dairy, food, and meat sciences. Three scholarships are awarded per year and previous applicants and recipients may reapply.

Instructions for the \$2,000 Technical College student award and the \$3,000 undergraduate or graduate student award application

The applicant must meet the following criteria to be considered for an award.

Will be attending or is attending an accredited two-year technical school or college or four-year college or university in Wisconsin or a school with a reciprocity agreement with Wisconsin. Enrollment in one-year certificate programs also qualify. If attending a school outside of Wisconsin or without a reciprocity agreement with Wisconsin, applicants having internship experience with a Wisconsin company will also be considered.

Full time student status as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior in 2020/2021.

Majoring in Environmental Sanitation, Culinary Arts, Food Microbiology, or Dairy, Food, Meat Sciences or closely related major to be eligible for the scholarships.

The applicant must submit the three application documents to be considered for an award.

The completed scholarship application

One copy of an official or unofficial transcript.

A written recommendation from a reference familiar with your academic activities and work history. This may be emailed directly to WAFP by the advisor or instructor or attached to the application.

Instructions for the E. H. Marth Food Protection and Food Sciences Scholarship

Eligibility requirements are:

Applicant must have completed a minimum of one (1) year in an accredited post high school undergraduate degree or diploma program (university, college, or technical college) in Wisconsin or an out-of-state school with a reciprocity enrollment agreement with Wisconsin.

Applicant must be enrolled in an Environmental Sanitation or Dairy Science/Food Science/Food Microbiology/Meat Science or closely related major to be eligible for the scholarship.

Include the following documents for your application to be complete:

1. The scholarship application
2. One copy of an official or unofficial transcript
3. A recommendation from an advisor or instructor which should address scholastic ability, professional potential, applicable work experience, extra-curricular activities, financial need and any other relevant information. This may be emailed directly to WAFP by the advisor or instructor or the applicant can attach to their online application.

Applicant instructions for completing the form:

1. Type or print clearly in black ink.
2. Give specific and complete answers to all questions. If a question does not apply to you, please answer with the letters N/A (not applicable).
3. Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:
 1. Application properly completed and submitted before the deadline.
 2. Advisor/Instructor recommendation.
 3. Academic achievement.
 4. Financial need.
 5. Work experience.
 6. Extra-curricular activities.
 7. Student comments
4. The scholarship recipient will receive the cash award after providing confirmation of registration for the next term to WAFP's scholarship committee.
5. The decision of the selection panel is final.
